Sanitation System Panning

Tuesday May 8, 2007 I met with Brian R. Buchheit, VP HMG, P.E., to obtain an update on the sewer system planning and development. He mentioned that the first step would be to set up a legal entity. A Sewer District at this time is preferred. A Sewer District would have the power to levy a tax. The tax would assist in providing additional money to operate, and retire any loan needed to finance the project. We need an attorney to help with the legal aspect of developing the district. Also we need to complete a survey of property owners in Royal Lake Resort No.2 Brian will provide us with the necessary form to complete the survey.

HMG completed the design of the system some years ago and will continue with us throughout completion. Brian mentioned that the following funds may be available: 1) a maximum loan in the amount of \$350K from the Department of Community Economic Opportunity maybe applied for, 2) a 50/50 Loan /grant may also be applied for from Rural Development as well as we should look into funds from 3) Unsecured Communities if available. Today's cost for construction is about \$1.5M

Attorney Bernard G. Heiligenstein, LTD has been working close with me so far and I'll let you know more. HW Rowell
