- Clinton County Probation and Parole**, to work with Royal Lake Improvement Committee providing service workers to help resident with clean up

We have encountered a problem with securing a dumpster. Santa Fe Township provided the dumpster last time out in 2012, and request we look for another resource with this project. They will however participate. Wade Township is on board, but Carlyle Township declined, due to smallness on territory. Royal Lake Improvement Committee has not indicated acceptance at this time. Clinton County Probation and Parolee will participate but service workers are limited, due to a change in programming.
